Jehoshaphat was king in Judah.

2 Chronicles 20:31-33

2 Chronicles 17:1-11

He sought after God (verses 3-5).

He rejoiced in the way of the Lord (verse 6).

He had God's word taught (verses 7-9).

He was blessed by God (verse 5, 10-19)

**2 Chronicles 20:1-2** 

The Moabites, Ammonites, Meunites came to fight.

News of this made Jehoshaphat afraid.

The prayer of Jehoshaphat

2 Chronicles 20:3-13

He prayed with great confidence (verse 3-5).

He focused on God's power (6-9).

He rehearsed what God had done in the past (6-9).

He spoke to God about his problem (10-11).

He recognized his total dependence on God (12-13).

#### God's Answer

2 Chronicles 20:14-30

The word of the LORD came to the people (vs 14-15).

They were to listen carefully (15).

They were not to be afraid or discouraged (15-17).

The battle belonged to the LORD.

They were to go against their enemies.
